HLTREM408B	<b>Apply Massage Assessment Framework</b> Describes the skills and knowledge required to interpret information gathered in the health assessment and make and review an accurate assessment for basic massage treatment.
HLTREM409B	<b>Perform Massage Health Assessment</b> Describes the skills and knowledge required to observe the condition of the client and gather information relevant to the case in order to provide a basic massage.
