WRBCS203B	Provide Service to Clients Describes the competencies required to deliver service to clients, including receiving clients, making appointments and responding to client complaints.
WRBCS204A	Apply Knowledge of Nail Science to Nail Services Describes the knowledge required to apply nail science to beauty treatments. Applies to a range of treatments relating to nails and to a range of roles in the workplace.
WRBCS305A	Apply Knowledge of Skin Biology to Beauty Treatments Describes the knowledge required to apply the principles of skin biology to beauty treatments. Applies to a range of beauty treatments and roles in the workplace.
WRBCS306B	Advise on Beauty Services Describes the skills and knowledge required to advise clients on a range of beauty services.
WRBCS407A	Develop a Treatment Plan for Beauty Therapy Treatments Describes the skills and knowledge required to consult with clients, assess treatment needs and develop a treatment plan for single or multiple treatment sessions for one or more services.
WRBCS408A	Apply Knowledge of Anatomy and Physiology to Beauty Therapy Treatments Describes the knowledge required to apply anatomy and physiology to beauty therapy treatments.
WRBCS409A	Apply Knowledge of Skin Science to Beauty Therapy Treatments Describes the knowledge required to apply the principles of skin science and skin disorders to beauty therapy treatments.
WRBCS410A	Apply Knowledge of Electricity to Beauty Therapy Treatments Describes the knowledge required to apply the principles of electricity to beauty therapy treatments.
WRBCS411A	Apply Knowledge of Nutrition to Beauty Therapy Treatments Describes the knowledge and skills required to apply the principles of nutrition to beauty therapy treatments.
WRBCS412A	Apply Knowledge of Cosmetic Chemistry to Beauty Therapy Treatments Describes the knowledge required to apply the principles of cosmetic chemistry to beauty therapy treatments.

WRBFS202B	Design and Apply Make-up Describes the skills and knowledge required to design and apply suitable make-up techniques for domestic street wear, business, pleasure, social and special occasions for various times of the day or night.
WRBFS305B	Provide Lash and Brow Treatments Describes the skills and knowledge required to analyse the lash and brow needs of clients and provide a range of shaping, perming and colouring services. Applicable as a discreet service or as part of a treatment plan.
WRBFS406B	Provide Facial Treatments Describes the skills and knowledge required to perform a range of manual facial and skin treatments.
WRBFS407B	Provide Advanced Facial Treatments Describes a higher level of skills and knowledge required for the assessment of client's skin and the performance of advanced facial treatment procedures.
WRBSS302B	Provide Temporary Epilation and Bleaching Treatments Describes the skills and knowledge required to analyse the temporary hair removal/bleaching needs of clients and provide the necessary service/s in a safe and hygienic manner.
WRRLP1B	Apply Safe Working Practices Incorporates the National Occupational Health and Safety Commission (NOHSC) guidelines for occupational health and safety. Encompasses the skills, knowledge and attitudes to maintain a safe work environment for staff, clients and others. Involves observing basic safety and emergency procedures.
WRRER1B	Work Effectively in a Retail Environment Encompasses the skills, knowledge and attitudes required to work effectively in a retail environment. Involves acting responsibly and in a non-discriminatory manner, and identifying the relevant award/agreement.
WRRCS1B	Communicate in the Workplace Encompasses the skills, knowledge and attitudes required for effective communication with clients and other staff in the workplace. Involves establishing contact with clients, processing information, working in a team, maintaining personal presentation, following routine instructions, reading and interpreting retail documents & using numbers in the workplace.
WRRS1B	Sell Products and Services Involves the skills, knowledge and attitudes required to sell products and services in a retail environment. Involves the use of sales techniques and encompasses the key selling skills from approaching the client to closing the sale. Requires a basic level of product knowledge.

WRRM2B	Perform Routine Housekeeping Duties Encompasses skills, knowledge and attitudes required to maintain and organise work areas in a retail environment.
WRRM1B	Merchandise Products Encompasses skills, knowledge and attitude to merchandise products within a retail store.
WRRM6A	Create a Display for Small Business Encompasses competencies required to plan and implement a display for a small retail business.
WRBSS201B	Pierce Ears Describes the skills and knowledge required to pierce ear lobes for ornamentation.
